











## Key Stage 2 Long Term Planning Overview of Topics

<b>Year A (2015-2016)</b>	<b>Ancient Civilisations</b>  <p>Would you like to have lived in Ancient times? The children will journey far back into the past and imagine what life would be like in these fascinating times.</p>	<b>Disaster!</b>  <p>We will be learning about how natural phenomenon and the weather can affect the planet as well as thinking about the effect that people have and what can be done about it.</p>	<b>Lucky Dip</b>  <p>We will be choosing our topic with the children by thinking about everyone's interests or what's going on in the world or anything else that sparks our imaginations!</p>
<b>Year B (2016-2017)</b>	<b>British History</b> <p>Who knows where this topic will take you? Maybe you will find yourself in a Victorian workhouse or at the court of King Henry VIII or even travelling all the way back to the Stone Age.</p> 	<b>South America - Rainforests - Chocolate</b> <p>We will travel deep into the heart of the Amazon rainforest as we find out all about its plants, animals and way of life. We will also learn about fair trade, thinking especially about chocolate!</p> 	<b>Take One ...</b> <p>In this popular topic, each class will choose one story, book, author, film or picture as the focus of their learning for the term.</p> 
<b>Year C (2017-2018)</b>	<b>Invaders and Settlers</b>  <p>We will be finding out how Britain has been shaped by those who have invaded or settled here in the past.</p>	<b>Water</b>  <p>As well as finding out all about water in our local area, we will be learning about how some children in other countries cannot enjoy clean water as we do. In addition, we will be looking in detail at rivers and how these form.</p>	<b>World War II</b>  <p>From evacuees and the Blitz to rationing and Victory Gardens, this topic will explore life during World War II locally as well as across Britain and Europe.</p>
<b>Year D (2018-2019)</b>	<b>World History</b> <p>With so many exciting times to explore, we can't wait to get learning. Maybe you will find out all about the history of America including the fight for freedom and independence for all people. Or maybe you will learn about the Ancient Greeks and their influence on our lives today. Wherever you go, this is sure to be a very popular topic.</p>	<b>Another Culture</b> <p>We will be transported to the magic and mystery of an amazing country that is very different from our own when we will learn all about its culture, colour and contrasts.</p> 	<b>Local Study</b> <p>This topic will have a geographical and / or historical focus as we learn about, and explore, the area in which we live.</p>
