We follow the statutory guidance for EYFS. We consider the individual needs, interests, and stage of development of each child in our care, and use this information to plan a challenging and enjoyable experience for each child in all of the areas of learning and development.

Children in our youngest classes are immersed in the three prime areas of learning in a safe and stimulating environment. The balance between the areas of learning shifts as the children mature and gain in confidence.

As part of the whole school, we are involved in “Immersive Learning” and base our learning around an “essential question”.

We aim to create environments and experiences which encourage children to think creatively and explore the world as they see it. We recognise the importance of play based learning as well as the benefits that being outside can bring.
