<u>Ministers</u>

Each year 13 ministers are elected to school parliament. Their responsibilities cover different areas of school life and they are ambassadors for the school, signing a pledge once elected. They take part in interviews, show visitors around the school, collect golden tickets to give out prizes and help put into place the ideas of the school council. Each term they report back to the school what has been happening in their area.

School Councillors

Each year, two councillors are elected from each class ranging from year 1 to year 6. Their responsibilities are to take any concerns or ideas from their class to the council meetings and report back to the class.

House Captains



Each year, two year 6 pupils from each house are chosen as House Captains after an interview with members of the staff and parliament. Their responsibilities are to collect and count team points, host house meetings and organise teams for house events.

Sports Leaders



Each year 6 year 6 pupils are chosen as sports leaders after being interviewed by staff and parliament representatives. Their responsibilities are to help set up house sporting events , meet with the P.E. co-ordinator and help staff on sports day.

Bully Busters

Each year 2 pupils from each class are voted to become the class bully busters. They are responsible for supporting children who need someone to talk to in the playground about any problems with friends. They meet regularly with Mrs Hughes to discuss their work in the playground and choose friendship awards which they give out to pupils in their class each week.



Infant Mentors

Each year a number of year 6 pupils are chosen to be mentors in year 1 after an interview with Mrs Daylak.
