Speak in simple sentences using basic language structures. Develop accurate pronunciation and intonation and be understood. Present ideas and information orally. Show understanding in simple reading. Adapt and apply known language to create new ideas. Broaden vocabulary and develop their ability to understand new words, including using a dictionary.
