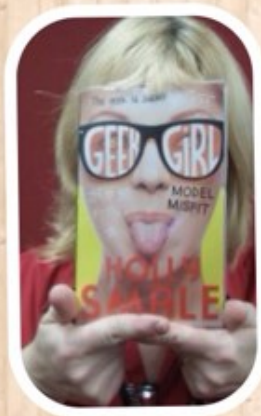
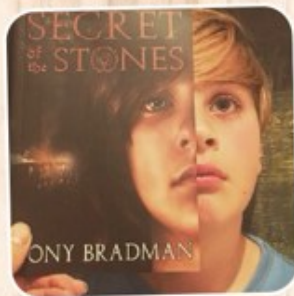
Get to know our Governors

Mandy O'Neill

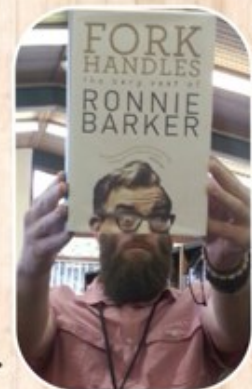

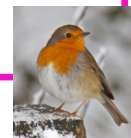
