

Early arrivals

Please note that there is no provision before school for unsupervised children other than at our Breakfast club. Recently some parents have been dropping off their children as early as 8.25am and leaving them outside the hall. We cannot take responsibility for their safety. Please can you either bring your child into the school grounds and wait with them until the doors open or make use of our Breakfast club. This is open from 8am and costs £2 to include breakfast.

Flu immunisation - please return your form by Monday 18th September

Nasal flu sprays are being offered this year to all children from Reception to Year 4 and the school nursing team will be in school in early October to deliver this immunisation. If you would like your child to have this, please complete the form that has come home and return it to the office as soon as possible but by Monday 18th September at the latest. The forms are being collected then so that they can be processed prior to the immunisation date. **Children without a form having been returned or whose form does not give consent, will not be given the spray.**

Wellies!

Don't forget that if your child would like to play on the field they need to have a pair of named wellies in school.

We currently have a form on file for almost every child in the school to let us know how you would like images of your children and examples of their work used in school, on our website, etc. If you haven't yet completed a form, we will be getting in touch with you to ask you to fill one in as soon as possible. If your consent has changed since you last completed the form, please ask at the office to amend your form with your up-to-date wishes. We do not ask you to complete a form every year and assume that your consent (or not) remains unchanged unless we hear from you.

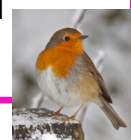
