All pupils are expected to wear school uniform.

We believe that a school uniform:

- Promotes in children a sense of pride and belonging to our school team and community;
- Ensures that all children, regardless of economic background, have a reasonable level of equity in the way they dress at school;
- Ensures that the high standards we seek to have throughout the school are exemplified through the children's smart appearance;
- Is practical and appropriate.

Children are expected to wear school uniform unless there is a justified reason why they cannot. If your child cannot temporarily wear uniform, please send in a letter stating the reasons why. If children do not wear appropriate school uniform, the school will be in contact with parents to discuss this.

Please note that all items of jewellery, apart from watches, are not allowed. For safety reasons, only stud earrings may be worn and these should ideally be removed for PE or alternatively covered with a plaster. Long hair should be tied back using plain bands without attachments. Children should not wear any make-up or nail varnish.

For sale at school office: Ties and swimming caps. For sale from Phoenix Promotions (using an order form available from the school office): Red school sweatshirts, tracksuit bottoms, red school tracksuit tops, Ducklings Nursery t-shirts, school PE bags, red shorts and red school book bags.

Children should wear:

- White shirts or blouses
- Red sweatshirts (school), jumpers or
- cardigans
- Grey trousers (or shorts in the summer term)
- Grey skirts, pinafore dresses or culottes
- School tie
- **Red checked** dresses (in the summer term)
- Plain white, black or grey socks or grey or red tights



All items of clothing should be plain and free from logos etc except any items incorporating the school badge.

Shoes:

Black shoes (not boots). All shoes should have a low heel.

Laces should be **plain black**. In the summer, **black** or **red** closed-toe sandals may be worn (not crocs).

PE Uniform

- Plain white polo shirt
- Plain red shorts
- Trainers or plimsolls

In the colder months, it is important that the children are dressed appropriately for outdoor PE and they may wear a school tracksuit for outdoor games.



Reception Children

Reception children (Robins and Choughs) should wear the same uniform as detailed on the previous page except that they wear red polo shirts instead of shirts or blouses and do not wear a school tie.

Once children move into Year 1, they will be expected to wear a white shirt or blouse with a school tie, rather than a polo shirt.

Reception PE Uniform

Again, Reception children should **wear the same PE uniform** as detailed on the previous page.



They may wear their tracksuits all day on PPA days (Mondays) and on swimming days (Wednesdays during the Summer Term).

Ducklings Nursery children should wear a yellow Ducklings t-shirt and red school sweatshirt.



Please label all school uniform with your child's name. This is especially important, as uniform items look similar and can easily be confused for another child's. The school cannot accept responsibility for any lost items.
