Punctuality

We are finding that quite a number of children are arriving late at school on a daily basis. The school doors open at 8.45am to give your child plenty of time to arrive and settle before the formal start to the school day at 9am. Even just a few minutes late can mean that they have missed the opportunity to say hello to and chat with friends and are likely to feel unsettled and embarrassed as they start morning lessons.

If you arrive after 9am we will ask you to sign the late book at the office whichMr Higgs monitors on a weekly basis.

If your child arrives after the register closes at 9.30am, this counts as an unauthorised absence and will show on your child's attendance record. Not only has your child missed the chance to meet with their friends before school, they are likely to have missed the start of lessons which are key to your child's learning and they may well feel much less confident than their classmates as the lesson moves on.

Please ensure that you get your child to school before 9am so that they are settled and ready to start work on time.

Clubs

All clubs start on **Monday 14th** and if your child put in a clubs form, they should have received it back showing which clubs they are doing. Many clubs have long waiting lists so if your child does not commit to attending regularly, their place will be given to the next person on the list. If your child is not attending a club for any reason, please let us know so that this can be put on the club's register for that day.

If your club requires payment, please ensure that it is received before the date of the first club or your child will not be able to be start.

Please collect your child promptly at the end of their club. If you are going to be late to collect them, please contact Go Active to book them into their after school provision on 07843 126833.

School camp payments

A reminder that the total payment for camp are due on the following dates:

If you cannot pay online, please ask at the office for a Paypoint barcode which you can use to pay cash at a local Paypoint retailer.
