



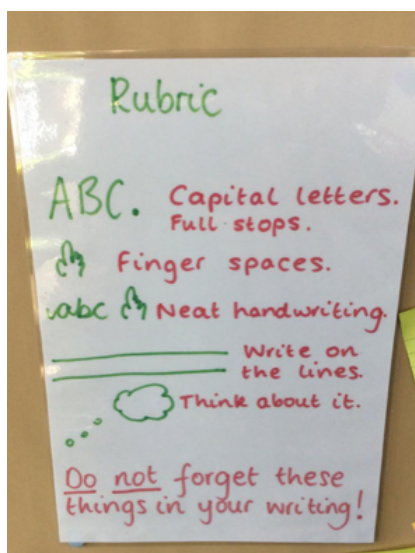

	<p>Watch the story again here if you need to: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=oOPIbOV3YFY</p> <p>Today it's time to plan a recount for a postcard - you will become Little Phil and write to a friend to tell them everything that happened that day! You can use the sentences from yesterday to help you. There are some resources below to help you plan! Don't forget to check your rubric!</p>

Download the worksheet from the school website.</p> <p>Login to Reflex Maths and aim to get a 'Green Light'. This should take you about 20 minutes if you concentrate.</p>
	<p>Watch the Surfers Against Sewage Ocean School lesson on Plastic Pollution (WEEK 6) and then have a go at the plastic timeline challenge sheet! https://www.sas.org.uk/digital-ocean-school#</p> <p>Bonus challenge: be a plastic investigator at home (see sheet below)</p>
	<p>Practise your spellings for our test on Friday! Why not try writing them into silly sentences?</p> <p>Play a few games on Spelling Shed (or Nessy if you have an account).</p>

	<p>Take one of your spelling words. Can you put it into all four different types of sentences?</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A <u>statement</u> (a telling sentence) 2. A <u>question</u> (an asking sentence - Don't forget the ?) 3. A <u>command</u> (a bossy sentence telling someone to do something) - 4. An <u>exclamation</u> (a sentence beginning with What or How and ending with an exclamation mark (Don't forget the !)) <p>Remember your ascending and descending letters and don't forget your punctuation. ABC . ? !</p>
	<p>Read for at least 20 minutes and talk to an adult about your book.</p> <p>Why not send me a book review to post on the website for your friends?!</p>
	<p>Aim for at least 30 minutes of physical activity a day - ideally a lot more!</p> <p>You could join in with PE with Joe, go walking, running or cycling or try some of the activities on our 'Be Active' page!</p>
	<p>Try to have at least 3 'story-times' a day!</p> <p>Listen to Mr Dawe or other teachers reading books on the school website. Listen to a parent read to you and choose a free audiobook to listen to together here ... https://stories.audible.com/discovery</p>

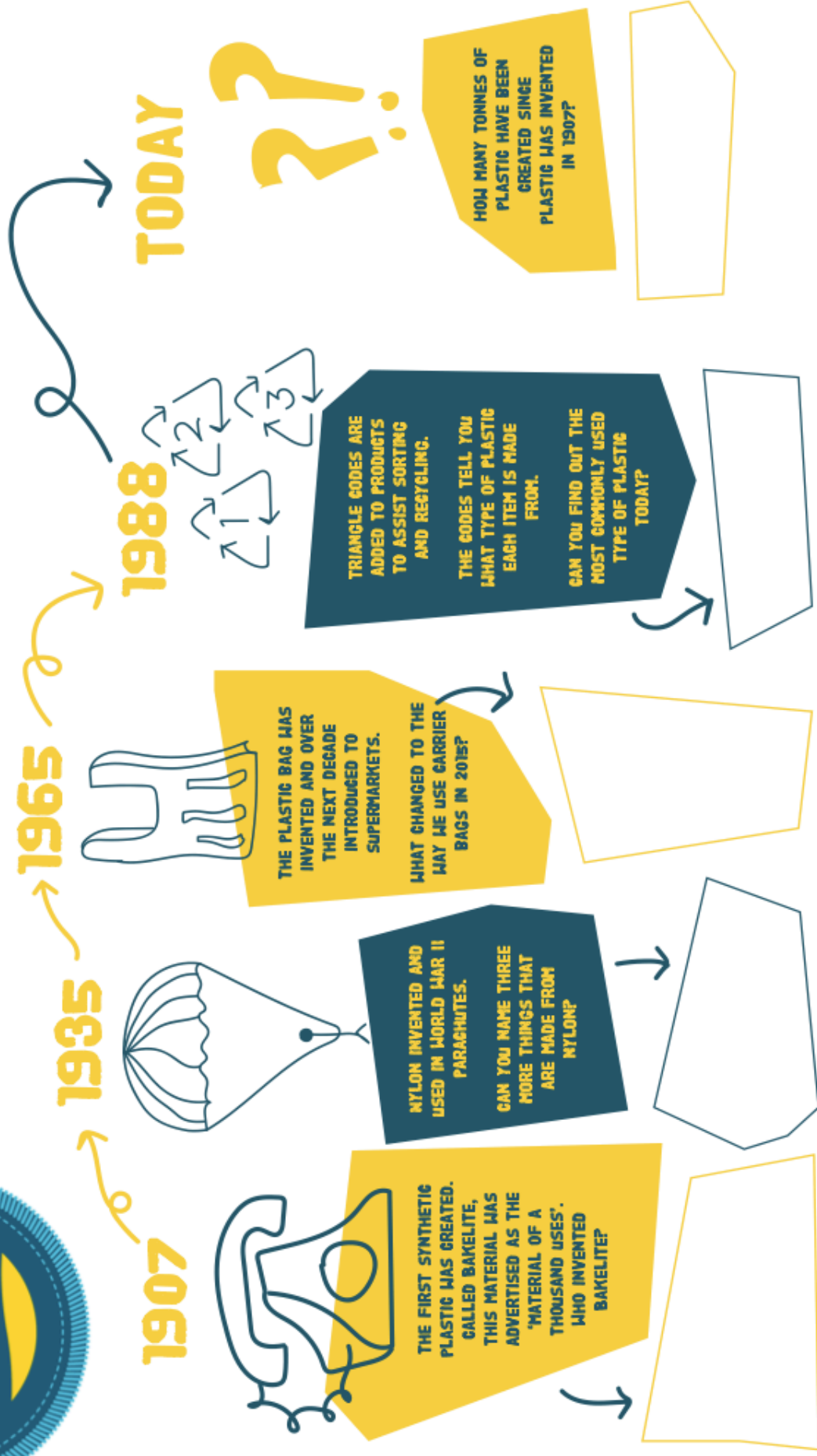
