<u>English</u>: This week we are going to watch the film of the "Ugly Sharkling" by Lawrence Hiller. We will write a character description and then write a postcard in role as Little Phil.

So you get to understand the story well you are going to sequence some pictures in chronological order. This just means putting them in the order that they happened in the story and you may need to watch the film a few times to help you do this. You can either cut and stick them in the right order or just give them numbers to show which order they should be in. When you have them in the right order, retell the story to someone – you could even dress up like you're at the beach!
