We will be doing lots of D.T- making the Mazey image and individual models. Pupils will also make mini dioramas of WWII scenes.

British Values

The children will be learning all about the Jewish religion. They will find out about the history of the religion, Jewish customs and beliefs and worship in the synagogue. We will reflect on the experience of Jewish people during the war.

English

Year 6 will be preparing for SATS. Year 5 will write a Friend or Foe WWII story and a newspaper report about The Battle of Britain. they will do instructional writing about what to do in an air raid and some WWII based poetry.

History

We will immerse the children in the history of this fascinating period from the launch day where everyone will be 'in role' as teachers and pupils of a school at the outbreak of war.

The children will learn all about the reasons for WWII and key events like Dunkirk, D day and The Battle of Britain. Alongside this we will explore what life was like for children during this period through a variety of challenges to do with rationing, black outs, air raids etc.

The children will also take part in a cornwall archive workshop which will focus on Cornwall during the war.

Maths

In our maths lessons we will continue to follow the curriculum with a particular focus on mastery through applying and problem solving. Alongside this there will be many opportunities for WWII based maths challenges.

Outdoor learning

We will be doing outdoor survival days on the field, outdoor challenges and our Moors walk will take place on Friday 15th June where the children walk the 6 miles back to school doing fieldwork.
