# **VERY IMPORTANT**

Safer Internet sessions for parents - Thursday 15th June

**1.30pm start** – a chance to look at some of the I.T. happening in your child's class followed at **2.15pm** by, a must-hear talk from Peter Bower from the UK Safer Internet Centre. He is a national expert on the challenges and opportunities which face your children and yourselves as parents with social networking, gaming, online friendships and the very fast pace of change around all internet related issues.

This session will finish in time for you to collect your child at the end of school and we strongly recommend that you attend this if at all possible.

**6.00-7.00pm** – Peter Bower will stay on to deliver an adults-only session, again looking at the dangers and opportunities that face young people on the internet at present. This will include social media, online bullying and gaming. It's an adults-only session in order to allow issues to be discussed that cannot be included with children present. This later session may suit parents who work in the afternoon.

There will also be a chance for parents who attend to win a Kindle Fire via a raffle which we hope will be an added incentive for you to attend.

As a school, we regularly deal with issues involving pupil misuse or the internet outside of school where parents are both horrified and unaware that there is a problem until it's too late. The only way to protect your child properly is to have your knowledge updated and this is a great opportunity to do so. There is no need to book, please just turn up at the session, or sessions, you would like to attend.

#### School crossing patrol vacancy

We have been successful in our campaign to improve road safety by providing a school crossing patrol at the end of Toltuff Crescent. However, it falls to us to recruit a crossing patrol person and we would rather offer it to someone in our community so a vacancy has now become available.

This would perfectly suit someone with school age children and probably would not affect any tax credits. This position would be term time only, 5-6 hours per week at £7.50 per hour. Free childcare available whilst you are working for your child if they are an Alverton school pupil. The hours would be 8.30-9am and 3-3.30pm daily with uniform and training provided.
