Could you spare a little time on a regular basis during the school day to support the children's learning ?


We are always in need of additional adults to read with children. If you can help, please drop in **after school** and speak to your class teacher.

Working Together

Throughout the year it is natural that you or your child may have concerns and we are more than happy to discuss these with you. Home Learning

We cannot emphasis enough how important it is that children's learning in school is supported at home. This is especially true of reading. To become



confident and fluent readers, children need to practise daily in school and at home. Other homework activities are sent out termly with a range of activities to choose from. Please send in homework on Fridays. Spellings are also tested weekly on Fridays. In addition, children have access to a range Maths Apps that they can use at home, such as Reflex Maths and Hit the Button.

Rewards

In our classes, and throughout the school community, children are rewarded for good work and positive behaviour. They can be awarded

BARTS, house points, certificates, stickers, class rewards, Star of the Week and lunchtime awards.

This Term's Learning

This term all our learning is centred around the topic of Space.

Our essential question is ... What pants would aliens wear?

We will use this question (linking to the popular book 'Aliens love Underpants'), as a starting point to explore the exploration of our Solar System and our planet's place within it.

English

This term the children will be describing and aliens, writing a guide for visiting aliens and making up their own alien story!

Children will continue to practise

their handwriting and phonics daily. Grammar work will focus on word classes, sentence structures and punctuation.



Mathematics

In Maths this term the

children will learn about Place Value and continue to practise a range of calculation strategies. They will learn about number, money, measures, shape and space, time and data handling and apply this knowledge in solving real life problems.

Science

In Science we will be learning all about humans and other animals and their habitats and including this information in our 'Guide for Aliens'.

Music

In Music we will be listening to 'The Planets' by Gustav Holst, composing our own plane-

tary music and learning songs about our Solar System.



PSHE

Our learning will centre on establishing classroom routines and rules and on our shared British Values.

History & Geography

Our History learning will focus on



the lives of significant people and the race into Space. In Geography we will learn about the Earth as viewed from Space, naming our continents and oceans.



Art & Design Technology In Art we be using a variety of media, including marbling inks, to

explore making pictures of planets real and imagined.

We will also be designing and making underpants for visiting aliens. These will be on

We will be using APPs to learn the fundamentals of programming and about digital citizenship and how to stay safe online.



PE

In PE this term we will be doing dance and gymnastics.

RE

This term we will learning why the Bible is special and about Jesus and the story of Christmas.
