WWII Survive or Thrive?

In the Summer Term, we will be learning about WWII. As well as looking at how the war started, we will also be looking at life on the Homefront and how people pulled together to make the best of such a terrible situation. Will will begin with our launch event which will see us visiting Flambards tour the Britain in the Blitz exhibition before travelling to Helston Museum to experience life as an evacuee.

Events

This term, we will of course, be taking the children away to Bude for two days of adventurous activity. We are all very excited about our trip and we know that the children will have a fabulous time. As well as that, we have Sports Day to look forward to and Mazey Day to start preparing for. It's going to be a fun and busy final term!

English

We will begin the term by learning about evacuation. We will be writing stories based upon Jacqueline Wilson's 'Wave Me Goodbye' followed by creating diaries in the role as evacuees or soldiers. After that, we will be creating play scripts which will be set during the 1940's and then finally, writing explanation texts. A busy term ahead! We will, of course, retain a strong focus upon reading, which will be supported by our reading passports and reading karate scheme. Please continue to read regularly at home as well as learning spellings which are given out at the beginning of each half term. We have already sent out information about our new spelling scheme Spelling Shed.

Maths

In maths the children will be learning how to use a range of calculation strategies. They will learn about measures, shapes, money and fractions and will apply this knowledge when solving real life maths problems. Mental maths skills are an essential part of our learning and we will be focusing on tables knowledge. By the end of Year 4, the children should know all of their tables up to 12 x 12. Tables knowledge is so useful for many aspects of maths and builds the children's confidence considerably. We will of course be encouraging the children to continue to work towards achieving their Jedi

Science

In the first half of the Summer Term we will be finding out about electricity. This will also link to our DT learning this term and will have a strong link to our project. Next, we will be learning all about light, something people were very aware of during WWII and the blackouts.

Music

We will continue to explore different areas of music supported by the wonderful Mrs England, learning to play the ukelele as well as regular singing practise each week.

Humanities

This term's topic has a strong History focus. We will of course be finding out about the causes of WWII and the countries involved, however, we are going to be looking in more detail about life on the Homefront and how those not directly involved in the war itself were still very much a part of the war effort.

RE

This term our learning is based on Judaism. We will be looking at symbolism of artefacts, beliefs and ceremonies that form part of the Jewish faith. We will also look at elements of the Holocaust, and the effects it had on the Jewish people.


DT & Art
