



This Wordle was created by each member of staff giving the 3 words which first come to mind when the think about our school. The size of the word increases the more often it was offered.






### AS A MEMBER OF STAFF... By Percentage 2015-2017 in Agreement




#### **BEHAVIOUR & SAFETY (STAFF)** By Percentage 2015-2017 in Agreement




### **LEADERSHIP & MANAGEMENT (STAFF) By Percentage 2015-2017 in Agreement**





### TEACHING & LEARNING (STAFF) By Percentage 2015-2017 in Agreement




### OTHER AREAS OF SCHOOL LIFE (STAFF) By Percentage 2015-2017 in Agreement








#### Highest Percentage Reduction (in Agreement) between 2016 & 2017 - Staff




### Highest Points Reduction between 2016 & 2017 - Staff

### Parent Survey Results 2017 - Percentage Disagreeing or Strongly Disagreeing with the Statement




