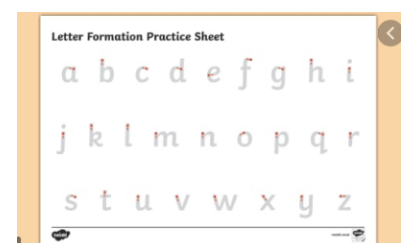

Handwriting

Make sure anything you write is correctly formed. There needs to be a difference between the heights of the letters.



English: (about 20 – 30 min)

This week we are going to watch the film of the book 'Ugly Sharkling' by Lawrence Hiller. We will write a character description and then write a postcard in role as Little Phil.

Monday

First watch the film clip 'The Ugly Sharkling'.

For you to understand the story well, we will sequence the pictures from the story. See images below.

Once you have cut out all the images, mix them up and try and correctly order the events from the beginning to the end. This is called 'chronological order'. Once you have ordered the pictures in the correct order, create a picture book, like you see in the film – 1:07, 1:14 etc). When you have done that retell the story to a member of your family. You could even wear some goggles and a snorkel!

Bonus challenge: can you add short captions to some or all of your pictures in your book?
