Dear Parents

As you will be aware, we received a visit from Ofsted on Wednesday of this week.

This was not entirely unexpected as the last inspection took place in June 2014. However, receiving an Ofsted phone call at lunchtime on Tuesday for an inspection starting at 8am on Wednesday did change our plans a little for this week.

As always with Ofsted inspections, we are not allowed to disclose the outcome until various formalities have been carried out. What I can say is that the children were, as always, an absolute credit to you and us in terms of their attitudes to learning, engagement, behaviour and manners. The school functioned as it always does with our dedicated and talented team doing their absolute best to keep 'business as usual' despite the considerable pressure of the inspection.

We are pleased that the inspector recognised the strengths of the school and that his findings matched our own self-evaluation very closely indeed; the staff team will go home this weekend for a well-earned rest, pleased that their hard work is being properly recognised.

Thank you to all of the parents who offered moral support to the staff this week, and a particular thanks to all of the parents who took the time to complete the inspection questionnaire in support of our school. These were noted by the inspector, who I believe was particularly impressed by the strength of positive feelings you expressed.

As soon as we can officially announce the outcome of the inspection, we will of course pass this on to you. In the meantime, I felt it appropriate to give you as much of a flavour of the outcome as I am allowed, given that you are a vital part of our wider school team.

Super swimmers!



Can we help you?


