
<u>PE Kits</u>

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English

Our English this term will begin with letter writing before moving onto some focused writing on story settings and recounts of all our activities. All the writing will have an environmental theme!

Science

In Science we will be exploring living things and their habitats, focusing particularly on how we can support pollinating insects. We will also be growing things and thinking about which materials can be reused and recycled.

Geography

We will be learning how to read and make maps as well as about seasonal change.

Computing

We will be using different applications to create digital content to promote a better understanding of how we can protect local environments. We will also be learning how to programme and how to stay safe online.

RE

In RE we will be learning some of the stories that Buddha told and thinking about what they can teach us. We will also consider the story of Easter.





Maths

In Year 1 we will continue working on addition, subtraction, place value and measures. In Year 2, we will begin with multiplication and division before moving on to fractions, shape and measures.

Art & Design

In art we will be inspired by the prints of William Morris and the paintings of Gustav Klimt before producing our own plant and minibeast inspired works of art!



Design Technology

We will investigate designs for bug hotels and bird feeders before making our own and reviewing them.
