# Key Stage 1 Autumn Term Overview 2019

#### English

Our English this term will be focused on practising all the skills needed to write a fact file about a famous explorer.

#### Science

In Science we will be exploring habitats and how they provide the needs of animals and plants. We will also look at simple food chains.



Maths

We will follow the White Rose scheme of Maths, building on all the children's prior knowledge.


# Art & Design

# Geography

#### History

# Computing

We will explore how to stay safe online as well as looking at ways to organise and store information.



In PE we will be completing an explorer themed dance unit and learning some invasion games.

#### RE

In RE we will be thinking about why the Bible is an important book for Christians and the meaning of the Nativity story.



#### **PSHE**

We will be following the 'Go Givers' scheme of work and linking it to our British Values themes.
