# Height & weight screening for Reception & Year 6 children

In October the children in Reception and Year 6 will be weighed and measured by the school nurses. All children in these years have received a booklet and "opt out" form about this. If you do **NOT** wish your child to be weighed or measured you must return the form to the office. By not returning the form, we assume you give your permission.

### Flu immunisation - Friday 19th October Reception to Year 5

All Reception to Year 5 children are eligible to have the nasal flu vaccination in school this term. A letter from the NHS giving full details about how to give consent for your child to have this in school has been emailed to you. If you would like a paper copy, please ask for one at the office. This year all parents must register and give consent <u>online</u> if you wish your child to have the vaccination and full details of how to do this is given in the letter. **Your child will not be vaccinated without your consent.** 

#### **Transfer to Secondary School**

If your child is currently in Year 6, you need to apply for their place at your preferred secondary school **by 31st October 2018**. The easiest way is to apply online at www.cornwall.gov.uk/admissions. For more information call the Admissions team on 0300 1234 101 or visit the website.

## Applying for a school place for September 2019

If you have a child born between 1st September 2014 and 31st August 2015 you need to apply for a school place in a Reception class for starting in September 2019. The deadline for applications is **15th January 2019.** The easiest way is to apply online at www.cornwall.gov.uk/admissions. #### PE kit

Please remember that **ALL** children from Year 1 upwards need to have a full PE kit in school all week. Apart from PPA days, your child will take part in other sporting activities with their teacher throughout the week and will need to change into it. Please bring it in on a Monday (named and in a bag) and take it home for washing on a Friday.

Our Harvest Festival will be held on **Thursday 11th October** at 9.30am and you are all very welcome to join us.
