ALVERTON TRAVEL PLAN - PARENT SURVEY OCTOBER 2015

Thank you to everyone who took the time to complete and return the survey questionnaire. We received 118 completed questionnaires representing 162 children. This level of feedback shows the strength of feeling which exists around this particular issue.

I have attached graphs to show the responses to the main questions which were asked as well as a copy of the written responses from parents relating to the main areas of perceived danger. To make this easier to interpret, I have added a rough map of the areas which were raised as a concern.

Main findings:


- We have a high proportion of children who arrive at school in a car.
- There are slightly more children who travel home on foot than arrive at school in that way.
- Many children appear to be dropped to school by parents as part of a journey to work.
- Personal/Road Safety and distance from the school are the main factors influencing how children travel to and from school.
- A large number of parents (42) indicated that they would use a walking bus to and from the Free Church Car Park if this was available.
- Parents considered that the greatest area of danger for children walking and cycling to school was in and around Toltuff Crescent, in particular the area immediately around the school gates and the road in front of the school. Many parents are very concerned about the fact that this is an area of high traffic congestion at the start and end of the school day. This has been a concern raised by parents and the school for many years.
- Another area of concern was the crossing point across the bottom of Trevena Road.

Proposed Actions

- As distance to school prohibits many children from walking or cycling to school, and with limited public transport available, we have to accept that a number of children will have to arrive at school by car. However, it is clear that many parents believe that vehicular traffic around immediately in front of the school presents the biggest risk of children arriving and leaving school. Therefore, we have created a manned access control point into Toltuff Road and Crescent in order to dissuade parents from driving down the school site. There will of course be exceptions to this, e.g. disabled badge holders. This access control will be operated by senior Alverton School Staff each morning and at the end of school.


- To request new warning signage and a manned crossing point around Treveana & Toltuff Roads
- Re-establish a Walking Bus service to and from the Free Church Car Park




Are there any places on the journey to/from school that you think makes them dangerous for pupils walking or cycling.




