After half term we will be concentrating on honing our scientific skills by designing and perfecting a range of experiments which will require different forms of scientific evaluation

Maths

In our maths lessons we will follow the curriculum with a particular focus on mastery through applying and problem solving. The Year Six children will be very busy in the run up to their SATs tests and will be consolidating their skills both in class and on a range of online tools.

Outdoor Learning

We will be taking advantage of the outdoor spaces as much as possible to help us understand how our world is changing. We will learn about the threats our planet faces and discover ways that we can make a difference.

Geography

In Geography, we will locating countries, continents and major features on the globe. We will then look at physical features like mountains, volcanoes, earthquakes and the water cycle.

After that, we will then look at aspects of human geography such as types of settlement and land use, economic activity including trade links, and the distribution of natural resources including energy, food, minerals and water. We will then look at how humans have influenced all these features in sometimes positive, but often negative ways with regard to our planet.

Music

In Music we will be building on our musical skills, using Music Express to improve our knowledge of beat, rhythm and pitch.

English

Year Five will be starting the term the poetry linked to climate change; they will then move onto writing a biography of Thomas Edison before writing a personal recount of the Titanic disaster. Year Six will be working on a series of fiction and non-fiction genre for their writing portfolios which will demonstrate their imagination, grammatical knowledge and vocabulary.
