

Hi KS1!

This week we are looking at the **u_e split digraph**. A split digraph is 2 letters that make one sound but which have another letter in the middle of them, like in the words **rude** and **cube**. (Parents/carers - you may have learned this as "magic e" but we don't use this term any more!) This **grapheme** (spelling) can make 2 **phonemes** (sounds) - an **oo** sound like in **June** and a **yoo** sound like in **huge**. This will be new learning for Year 1 and, although Year 2s have come across them before, split digraphs are always tricky so this will be good practice for their writing skills!
