English:

For the next five days, our writing will be based upon a short film of a book you might know called 'Owl Babies' by Martin Waddell. By the end we will have written our own amazing retelling of the story!

Today we are going to try and put the event in the film in the correct order.

First, watch the film here: <https://vimeo.com/55971653> You might like to watch it a few times to learn the order things happen in.

Discuss the film, try to use **time connective** words like, 'First', 'Next', 'Then', 'After that' and 'Finally' to order the events in the film. You could even act out the story pretending to be the owl babies you like?!

When you are confident you know what order things happened in the story, have a look at the Resource for Day 1 below. With an adult, cut out and read the sentences and see if you can put them in order. Get them all in the correct place before you stick them down.

Cut out and order the story.

They lived in a hole, in the trunk of a tree with their owl mother.



One night, they woke up and their owl mother was gone!

Sarah and Percy wondered where their mother had gone but Bill just wanted his mummy.

Once, there were three baby owls.



Sarah and Bill thought she'd be back very soon but Bill just wanted his mummy.

The hole had twigs and leaves and owl feathers in it.

The baby owls came out of their house and sat on the tree and waited.



They were called Sarah, Percy and Bill.

Sarah and Percy thought she might have gone hunting but Bill just wanted his mummy.

The wood was spooky and scary without their mother.



Sarah and Bill thought about all the nice things their mother would bring but Bill just wanted his mummy.

After that, the owls closed their eyes and wished their mother would return.

Just then, Sarah thought they should all sit together on one branch, so they did.

Finally, their mother returned. Soft and silent she swooped through the trees to Sarah and Percy and Bill.
