Our weekly English topic is designed to focus on and consolidate the key skills which the children should be secure in at the end of the year, whilst the White Rose resources are covering what we would be teaching in school right now. The wider curriculum activities are linked to the week's topic and the aim is to hopefully add a fun element for those who wish to do them!

I also saw that some people have suggested it may be useful to have the schedules in advance and from now on I will upload them all on Sunday evening, so you can have a look and decide what you would like to do the following week.
