

How do you do?


The focus for this term is the children themselves. As the children gain confidence in their surroundings we shall be exploring further afield. The children will be finding their way around the school doing number and letter hunts and learning all the routines that keep the class and the school a safe and exciting place to learn.

The children will be performing a Nativity based play to the audience and learning lots of songs to entertain you all with. In the classroom we anticipate Santa's workshop being a very busy place with children writing lists and cards, wrapping presents and delivering them around the classroom.
