
Year 6 London trip meeting

School lunch money

Verrucas

A few people have recently asked about what to do if their child has a verruca and is due to go swimming or to take part in gymnastics or dance at school.

Verrucas can be a real nuisance and are undoubtedly easy to catch. We have spoken to Penzance Leisure Centre for advice on what our practice should be for swimming lessons. They have said that while it is good practice to wear a verruca sock, it is something which is very difficult to monitor and the majority of people continue to swim barefoot.

In school, as conditions are not wet and damp for indoor PE (things which make verrucas spread more easily), we encourage parents to put a plaster over their child's verruca so that they can take part in lessons more comfortably whilst also reducing the possibility of spreading the virus.

Under normal circumstances, verrucas should not be a cause for a child to miss their PE lessons.
