Uniform reminder

Please remember that unless it is a non uniform day, we expect all the children to come into school in their correct uniform. For Year 1 to 6 this is as follows:

- White shirt (not polo shirt) and school tie
- Red school sweatshirts, V-necked jumpers or cardigans
- Grey trousers (or shorts in summer term)
- Grey skirts, pinafore dresses or culottes
- Red checked dresses (in summer term)
- Plain white, black or grey socks or grey or red tights

All items of clothing should be plain and free from logos etc, except any items incorporating the school badge.

Shoes:

- Black shoes (not boots) All shoes should have a low heel.
- Laces should be plain black.

Please note that all boots including ankle boots are not acceptable.

Reception children should wear a red polo shirt with no tie instead of a white shirt.
