Art/D.T.

We will be exploring printmaking with different methods and materials to explore effects and create our own dragons. In D.T. we will be investigating electrical systems which respond to the environment - we will link this to burglar alarms in galleries.

British Values/P.S.H.E.

We will spend a morning exploring the 4 elements of British Values.

We will be doing the Sex and Relationships Education units for each year group and will also learn all about managing money.

R.E.

We will focus on Christianity focussing on the nature God and the life of Jesus. Our painting will lead us to find out the stories and lives of the patron saints of the four British countries, exploring their links with the wider world.

Science

We will be investigating light - how it travels in straight lines, how objects can be seen and understand different light sources.

We will also be learning about materials - classifying them, understanding that some dissolve and conduct experiments.
