#### PART 1

We would like you firstly to find an artist you like, find out as much as you can about him and record your work in some way, either hand written or on a pic collage or pages/ word document. Below (because I like them) I have given you some links to some surrealist artists. If you look at Magritte for example, it may remind you of some of the Anthony Browne books. Picasso painted lots of different things but I just love his surreal faces. I am very keen on Miro because I think he is the most amazing doodle artist. (I have been doing lots of doodling whilst in Zoom meetings!)

However you need to choose an artist you like. Or look at the top the page and click on movement, maybe pop art or futurism, and look and see if there is anything you like there. There is amazing art work out there.
