AGE RESTRICTIONS

PEGI has given the game a rating of 12-4. Even thoogh the game includes violence and weapons such as crossbow, grenade leaunchers, rifles, pistols, shotguns and more, PEGI say "more graphic and realistic tooking violence towards fantasy characters is allowed. Dog fouling
